

Instructions for authors

Please, follow the instructions given below when typing manuscripts.

1. Page setup

Paper size: custom size, width 17, height 24, portrait,
Margins: top, bottom, left, right: 2 cm; gutter: 0 cm; header, footer: 1.25 cm.

2. The title must be written in Times New Roman, 12 pt., bold, capitals, centered.

One line free.

3. The name(s) of the author(s) must be written in Times New Roman, 11pt., italic, bold, capitals.

4. The author(s)' affiliation(s) including full postal and e-mail address(es) are given as footnote(s). In case of more than one author, the corresponding author must be identified with numbers in footnotes. Times New Roman, 9 pt., normal.

After author(s) name(s) two lines free.

5. Abstract should contain the purpose, the applied data and methods as well as the basic conclusion(s) of the paper.

Times new Roman, 10 pt., indentation 1.27 cm (for the whole abstract text), justified, single line spacing.

Word „abstract” will be in capitals, bold, followed by point. Title will be in bold.

One line free.

5. Keywords must be included up to 5 words or phrases to help to classify the topic. Times new Roman, 10 pt., word „Keywords” has to be in bold followed by „:”.

Two lines free.

Text

Text titles. The article may contain title up to 3 order (3.2.1. title...).

- a. First order title (1. TITLE...) has to be typed in Times New Roman, 11 pt., bold, capitals, indentation: 1.27 cm.
- b. Second order titles has to be typed in Times New Roman, 11 pt., bold, non-capitals, indentation: 1.27 cm.
- c. Third order titles has to be typed in Times New Roman, 11 pt., bold, italic, non-capitals, indentation: 1.27 cm .

Before a new title, whatever its order is, *one line free* is required.

Text body has to be typed in single spacing, 11 pt. Times New Roman font, justified, 1.27 first range paragraph indentation.

Use of S.I. units is expected, and the use of negative exponent is preferred to fractional sign.

Mathematical formulas have to be edited with Equation Editor. They are expected to be as simple as possible and numbered in parentheses at the right margin. All parameters of the formulas have to be specified. In the text body they will be type with italic characters.

Before a new title, whatever its order is, one free line is required.

Tables and figures

All tables and figures must be cited in the text body in their numerical order.

Tables should be numbered using Arabic numbers with their legends given below them. Avoid too lengthy or complicated tables. You can use lower font size in the tables if necessary, but not under 7 pt.

Title of the table should be typed in Times New Roman, 10 pt., bold, italics, centered.

E.g.:

Table 1. *The frequency of major basins included in hydrological warning messages in 2009*

Figures should also be marked with Arabic numbers fully in black and white. The captions have to be given inside or below them. Maps should have scale present.

Figures name are to be written in Times New Roman, 10 pt., bold, italics, centered, as it follows:

Fig. 2. *The frequency of hydrological warnings on major hydrographic basins in 2009*

Citation and references

All publications cited in the text should be presented in the list of references, arranged in alphabetical order. There are no accepted cited publication in the references list if they are not cited in the text.

Reference in the text should contain the name(s) of the author(s) and year of publication. E.g., in the case of one author: Petterssen (1969); in the case of two authors: Gamov and Cleveland (1973); and if there are more than two authors: Smith et al. (1990). If the name of the author cannot be fitted into the text, then it will be put in the brackets: (Miller, 1989); etc. When referring papers published in the same year by the same author, letters a, b, c, etc. should follow the year of publication. If there are many publications of the same authors as main (first) author, they will be ranged in chronological order.

References list must be edited in Times New Roman, 10 pt.. Titles will be automatically numbered, indentation of first line 1.27 cm. For each kind of publication, authors must follow the instructions:

For an article: name(s) of author(s), year inside brackets, title of article in Italics, name of journal, volume, number (the latter two in Italics) and pages. E.g.

1. Nathan, K.K. (1986), *A note on the relationship between photo-synthetically active radiation and cloud amount*. Időjárás 90, 10-13.

For a book: name(s) of author(s), year inside brackets, title of the book (in Italic), publisher and place of publication. E.g.,

2. Junge, C.E. (1963), *Air Chemistry and Radioactivity*. Academic Press, New York and London.

For a publication without authors (laws etc.), instead of authors, *** will be put and then year inside brackets, title in Italics, source (volume etc.). They will be mentioned at the end of the authors' list and ranged in chronological order.

3. *** (2004), *Ordonanța de urgență privind Sistemul Național de Management al Situațiilor de Urgență*, O.U. nr. 21/2004 din 15/04/2004, Monitorul Oficial, Partea I nr. 361 din 26 aprilie 2004.

For a website: site name followed by the date of accessing.

4. <http://www.inmh.ro> accessed on January, 25, 2010.

When cite a website, after typing the name, please remove hyperlink (click right button of the mouse, chose hyperlink and then click remove hyperlink).

In order to be published, the articles must be formatted according to the instructions for authors and to the sample which are attached to this message.

They will have an extension of maximum 8 pages. One author may participate with maximum one paper as first author and may be co-author to another paper.

Articles that will be submitted after the deadline or which do not respect the instructions for authors will not be published.

Reprints: first author will receive one reprint free of charge together with the conference documents. Additional reprints may be ordered on the authors' expense after receiving the acceptance of publication from the Editorial Office.
